Spinifex Circuit An arid water-carved landscape

Explore the Jump Up country via the Spinifex Circuit. This landscape appears harsh and dry, but it has not always been so. It was created and continues to be shaped by water. Runoff over the millennia is carving the landscape creating its distinctive gullies, hard-topped mesas and escarpments.

This track climbs the mesa overlooking the trackways building and returns to the carpark. The lookout has excellent views over Lark Quarry Conservation Park, the Mitchell grass downs to the east and the channel country in the west. Allow half an hour return.

The track is steep in places, and care must be taken at the lookout edges.

Wear walking shoes, a hat and carry water. This is a fragile landscape and easily eroded. Please stay on the walking track.
